RULES FOR THE EXHIBITION

1. The show is open to all persons from India and abroad.
2. Each Exhibitor will fill in the enclosed Entry Form or a facsimile thereof and send it along with appropriate entry fee, so as to reach the under mentioned not later than 5 p.m. on 21st February 2019 for pot plants etc.

The Entry fee must be remitted in CASH ONLY. Late Entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Society at double the entry fee, by 10 a.m. on 22nd February 2019. Exhibitors are requested to send their entries at an early date to avoid last minute rush. Pot plants may be brought to the Show ground at Ramleela Maidan, 21-A, by the evening of 21st February 2019 at Noida.

The entries for the gardens may be made by the 5th Feb. 2019. Judging of NOIDA/ GREATER NOIDA, Institutional Gardens on 11th Feb. 2019. Judging of NOIDA Residential gardens, private institutions, schools and colleges will take place probably on 12th & 16th Feb. 2019.

3. **The Show will be held at RAM LEELA MAIDAN, SECTOR 21-A, NOIDA and will be open to the public for two days, on 23rd Feb. Saturday and 24th Feb. Sunday, from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.**
4. Exhibits in pots must be arranged at the Show ground by 10 a.m., Friday 22nd Feb. 2019 for final Judging. **In general the size of the pot should not exceed 10" to 12". In exceptional cases specific sizes are mentioned in the classes.**
5. **Cut blooms/Roses/Vegetable Carving and Flower arrangement** competitions will be held on **Saturday 23rd February 2019.**
6. Cut flowers etc. shall become the property of the Society and shall be disposed off in the manner considered fit.
7. **The Exhibitors pots and trays etc., shall be returned to them after 8 p.m., on the 24th Feb. 2019 and these cannot be removed earlier under any circumstances.**

All possible care of the Exhibits will be taken, but Society/Authority cannot take any responsibility for loss or damage.

8. An Exhibitor may enter up to three Exhibits in each section. Separate fee shall be charged for each Exhibit entered, but an Exhibitor will be awarded only one prize in Section. All members of a household shall be treated as one Exhibitor and entries from one house hold shall be entered in one name.
9. Every exhibitor will be allotted an entry number. The card shall be tagged as provided by the Society and placed in front of the Exhibit. No alteration or addition to the exhibit card shall be made. The name of the Exhibitor shall not appear on the Exhibit. Exhibits by Nurserymen or professionals must not bear placards of price list/tags.
10. It will be necessary for Exhibitors to name the flowering cultivars exhibited by them. The labels provided by the Society shall be used for writing names. Exhibit with any other labels / markers shall be disqualified. The names shall be written in capital letters with ball point pen. **Only blue or black colour shall be used.** Exhibitor should ensure that the names written on labels do not become smudged or illegible.
11. All Containers for cut flower blooms etc., shall be provided by the Organiser.
12. All cut blooms shall be from the plants grown by exhibitor and should have been the exclusive property of the exhibitor for atleast 3 months prior to the date of FLOWER SHOW Special attention of exhibitor is invited to this rule which prohibits exhibition of blooms obtained through gift, purchase, by exchange or in any other way. In the case of Institutions, Nurseries etc. where the entry is not by an individual in his own capacity, the blooms exhibited shall be from plants growing in the gardens of aforesaid for atleast three months and shall not have been obtained by gifts, purchase, by exhibitor or in any other way from others whether individuals or corporate bodies. Pooling of exhibits or joint entries by more than one Institution, Nursery etc. is NOT permitted.
13. ALL INSTITUTIONS, COLLEGES, SCHOOLS, NURSERIES, FARM HOUSE AND EMBASSIES, SHALL BE DEEMED AS LARGE GROWERS, AND IN NO CASE WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER IN SMALL GROWER (OWNER OF 250 OR LESSER POT), AMATEURS CATEGORY. NO INDIVIDUAL CAN ENTER IN PLACE OF INSTITUTION, NURSERY, EMBASSY ETC. IN SMALL GROWER CATEGORY.

IN NOVICE CLASS-BEGINNERS, WHO HAVE NOT WON IN PREVIOUS SHOW WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER IN THIS CLASS.
14. All plants exhibits showing signs of having been lifted from the ground within the last three months prior to the show shall be disqualified.
15. **Exhibitors shall, if required, permit the persons as may be appointed by the Authority / Society to view their Nurseries / Garden, prior to or after the Show.**

16. Entry Fee is Rs. 30/- for exhibits in general. For bonsai & floral animals it is Rs. 50/- per entry and for the circular arrangements, it is **Rs. 100/-** entry.
17. For the Award of Rolling Trophies each first Prize will carry 3 points. Second Prize 2 points and Third Prize 1 point of credit.
18. **In Sections there will be one first prize of Rs. 100/- one Second prize of Rs. 70/- and one third prize of Rs. 50/-**

The judges may withhold any prize when, in their opinion, the exhibits do not merit the prize. They may also award an extra First, Second or Third prize in any Section in which the quality of an Exhibit, in their opinion, warrants their doing so. **For Bonsai, Cactus and Succulent, Flower arrangement, Vegetable carving and Novice class, Cups will be awarded to First, Second and Third, but no cash prize.**

19. The cups will also be given to first winners in other classes, where ever mentioned. The Second in this Section will get cash prize of Rs. 70/- and third Rs. 50/- only.
20. **Pot plants will be judged on the basis of the overall quality of the blooms viz. form, size, freshness, colour uniformity of foliage and balance. Cut flowers will be judged primarily on the basis of the overall quality of the blooms.**
21. In the event of an objection to the decision of the judges, an appeal can be made to the Flower Show Committee by depositing Rs. 200/- for every objection with the Secretary within half an hour after the judging is over. There upon the Flower Show Committee in its discretion, may request the judges to reconsider their decision. Subject to this the decision, of the judges shall be final. The deposit is non refundable.
22. **The Rolling Cups, Shields and Trophies shall be returned to The Floriculture Society Noida, not later than 31st December of the year. The winner, shall be responsible for the safe custody of the Challenge Cups, Shields and Trophies.**
23. All matters not covered by these 'Rules' shall be left to the discretion of the Flower Show Committee whose decision shall be final and binding.
24. **The EXHIBITORS scoring overall highest Aggregate Marks in the show will be awarded the following prestigious awards:-**
 - (1) Noida Chairman Rolling Trophy will be awarded to the 1st highest aggregate scoring exhibitor.
 - (2) Cash Award of Rs. 2500/- (Rs. Two Thousand Five Hundred only) from the Floriculture Society, Noida
 - (3) Greater Noida Chairman Rolling Trophy will awarded to the second highest aggregate scoring exhibitor.
 - (4) Cash award of Rs. 1500/- (Fifteen hundred only) from the Floriculture Society, Noida

2. Artistic arrangement of pots of **one Annual** (except Dahlia) in pots in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the surface of the ground. An edging of foliage can be used.

3. Artistic arrangement of pots of **dahlia** in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the surface of the ground. An edging of foliage can be used.
4. Artistic arrangement of pots of **foliage plants** in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the surface of the ground.
5. Artistic arrangement of pots of **Calendula** in one or more colours in a circle, not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the surface of the ground. An edging of foliage can be used.
6. **Artistic arrangement of pots of Cineraria** in one or more colours in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the surface of ground. An edging of foliage plants can be used.
7. **Artistic arrangement of pots of Pansy** in mixed coloured in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the ground surface. The top centre of the arrangement should be of Violas of mixed colours (Yellow & Blue), arranged in a diameter of 45 cms. An edging of Violas of mixed colours in pots to be placed in a single row.
8. **Artistic arrangement of flower pots to depict VASANT (SPRING)** having solid yellow colour of one or more Annuals having its center with 25 cm in diameter pure white annual flower pot arrangement, in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the ground. An edging of Single Colour Blue & Violet Colour annual pots can be used.
9. Artistic arrangements of pots in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in mixed colours of **Marigold** of any variety. An edging of foliage can be used.
10. **Artistic arrangement of pots of Nasturtium** in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter without disturbing the surface of ground. An edging of foliage plants can be used.
11. **Artistic arrangement of single Petunia Flower pots** having blooms of different colours in a circle not exceeding **2.5 meters** in diameter, without disturbing the surface of the ground with different colour double Petunia pots in 45cm (1.5 Feet) diameter circle in the centre. An edging of different coloured Petunia pots is to be provided all around the circle.
12. **Artistic arrangement of Antirrhinum** flowers of any variety in a circle not exceeding 2.5 metres in diameter, without disturbing the surface of the ground.
